County Extension Activities June 7 – June 20, 2017

General Extension Activities:

- Extension Staff assisted local citizens regarding palm tree disease, injured wildlife, invasive species, soil tests, fruit trees, and other topics.
- Attended Apalachicola SWIM Plan meeting to stay current on this process by the NFWFMD.

Sea Grant Extension:

- Extension Director participated in the weekly planning calls for the Dark Skies turtle lighting project. Purchase of lighting supplies for first round of retrofits has been accomplished.

Agriculture/Horticulture:

- Extension Director is working with other UF Faculty and Dept. of Agriculture experts to implement a bio-control effort aimed at slowing the spread of Citrus Greening in the County. This will involve the release of a host-specific, parasitic wasp that preys on the larvae of the Asian citrus psyllid, which spreads the greening disease from tree to tree. Wasps to be released into known populations of psyllids that have been identified by insect sampling activities over past several months.
- This method has proven effective in other places to significantly reduce psyllid populations with no known negative in the environment. Wasps were tested with native psyllids and did not parasitize any of the test species except for the Asian citrus psyllid.
