She stated they do not know how much is coming back yet. Commissioner Boldt reported the county must have good credit rates. Mrs. Griffith responded yes, the county is in good standing, pays their bills and do not have a lot of debt. She explained this is good so in times when the tax base expands or contracts because Franklin County is able to stay stable. Motion carried; 5-0.
