## FRANKLIN COUNTY, FLORIDA REQUIRED ANALYSIS FOR LAND USE OR ZONING CHANGE

- Eastpoint Urban Service Area Is the property located in the Eastpoint Urban Service Area?
- **Coastal High Hazard Area** Is the property located in the Coastal High Hazard Area?
- **Critical Shoreline Zone** Is the property located in the Critical Shoreline Zone?
- **Soil Conditions** Copies of the 1994 Soil Survey of Franklin County are available from the Franklin County Planning Office.
- **Topography** What is the topography of the property?
- **Drainage** Are there any natural drainage features located on the property?
- Wetlands The only way to definitively know if there are wetlands on the property is to have a qualified individual survey the site for wetlands, but the U. S. Fish and Wildlife Service's National Wetlands Inventory can give a general overview of what potential wetlands might be located on the property. - **Floodplains** What flood zone is this property located in? The flood maps for Franklin County can be found at portal.nwfwmdfloodmaps.com.
- **Potential Wildfire Areas** Is the property susceptible to wildfires?
