**FRANKLIN COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS  
REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS

The Franklin County Board of County Commissioners is seeking civil engineering services relating to the construction engineering and inspection (CEI) for the widening and resurfacing improvements on County Road 67 from State Forest Road 172 to the Liberty County Line. The total length of the project is 2.6 miles. The scope of the project includes widening and resurfacing the existing lanes, minor drainage improvements including cross drain and side drain reconstruction, where needed and signage upgrades and pavement markings. Consideration will be given to only those firms that are qualified pursuant to law and that have been prequalified by FDOT to perform the indicated types of work.

Work Types: 10.1 – Roadway Construction Engineering Inspection  
Response Deadline: June 03, 2025, at 4:30 P.M. Eastern Time  
Opening Date: June 04, 2025, at the County Commission meeting which begins at 9:00 A.M. Eastern Time

This project is funded with assistance from the FDOT. By submitting a letter of response, the Consultant certifies that they are in compliance with FDOT Procedure No. 375-030-006 (Restriction on Consultants Eligibility to Compete for Department Contracts) and that no principle is presently suspended, proposed for debarment, declared ineligible or voluntarily excluded from participation on this transaction by any government department or agency.
