

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FRANKLIN COUNTY COMPREHENSIVE PLAN TO CHANGE THE PERMITTED LAND USE OF LOTS 17, 18, 19, 20, AND 21, BLOCK S, LANARK BEACH, FROM RESIDENTIAL TO COMMERCIAL.

**ORDINANCE 98-27
FRANKLIN COUNTY, FLORIDA**

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Florida has received a recommendation from the Franklin County Planning and Zoning Commission for changing the land use of certain private real property, and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County has conducted a public hearing with due public notice,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE FRANKLIN COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS that:

The permitted land use of Lots 17, 18, 19, 20, and 21, Block S, Lanark Beach, as shown on the attached map, is changed from Residential to Commercial, subject to leaving a twenty feet vegetated buffer along the northern property line of Lot 17.

This Ordinance adopted this 1st day of December, 1998, in a regular meeting of the Franklin County Board of County Commissioners after notice was duly given, and pursuant to Chapter 163, Florida Statutes. This Ordinance shall take effect when notice of receipt of a certified copy of same is returned from the Secretary of State.
