

AN ORDINANCE WAIVING BUILDING PERMIT FEES FOR REPAIR OF STORM DAMAGE UNTIL DECEMBER 26, 1985.

EMERGENCY ORDINANCE NO. 85-2

FRANKLIN COUNTY, FLORIDA

WHEREAS, Hurricane Kate, following Hurricane Elena, has wreaked great havoc in Franklin County, and


WHEREAS, the great damage to existing buildings and structures in Franklin County needs to be repaired, and the Franklin County Board of County Commissioners wishes to assist in this to the extent of its ability to do so, and

WHEREAS, an emergency exists in Franklin County because of Hurricane Kate,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE FRANKLIN COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, that building permit fees for repair of storm damage is waived until December 26, 1985, for permits issued for storm damage repair, provided that said permits and the construction performed conform to the Franklin County Building Code and Ordinances.

This ordinance is adopted in open session this 26th day of November, 1985, and the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Florida hereby declares that an emergency exists as recited herein, and immediate enactment of this ordinance is necessary, four members of the said board being present and, having waived notice, unanimously voted for this ordinance as an emergency ordinance.
