

FRANKLIN COUNTY ROAD SPEED LIMITS

ORDINANCE NO 80-2
FRANKLIN COUNTY, FLORIDA

WHEREAS, certain county roads in Franklin County, Florida have heavy traffic and have become residential throughfares, and it has become necessary to limit permitted speed of vehicles using said road, and

WHEREAS, it has become necessary that a 35 mile per hour speed zone be established on the below described county roads, and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Florida deems it necessary, in order to promote the health, safety, morals, welfare, and convenience of the public in Franklin County, to establish the following 35 miles per hour speed zones.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY, FLORIDA:

1. The lands adjoining the following County roads are hereby declared to be business or residence districts within the meaning according to Section 317.233, Florida Statutes.

2. The following county road are hereby declared to county speed zones, as to which the maximum lawful speed shall be 35 miles per hour in the daytime or nighttime:

All of Bluff Road, County Road 384, from the City limits of Apalachicola to its end;

All of Magnolia Bluff, County Road 65;

All of Airport Road, also known as Brownsville Road, County Road 384, from the City limits of the City of Apalachicola to the East line of the County owned Airport.

This Ordinance adopted in open regular meeting this 3rd day of June, 1980, after notice of intent to consider the same has been made and kept in the Ordinance Book of the Clerk of the Board for at least 15 days exclusive of Sundays and legal holidays, and the title and substance hereof published according to law in the Apalachicola Times, a newspaper of general circulation within the County.

This Ordinance shall take effect when notice of receipt of a certified copy of same is returned from the Secretary of State.
