WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Florida has received a recommendation from the Franklin County Planning and Zoning Commission for rezoning certain private real property, and


WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County has conducted a public hearing with due public notice,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE FRANKLIN COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS that:

Lots 10, 11, 12 & 13, Block 5 East, Unit 1, St. George Island, as shown on the attached map, is rezoned from C-2 Commercial Business to C-4 Commercial / Residential Mixed Use.

This Ordinance adopted this 2nd day of DECEMBER, 2003, in a regular meeting of the Franklin County Board of County Commissioners after giving notice of intent to adopt it as a rezoning of less than 5% of the County. This Ordinance shall take effect when notice of receipt of a certified copy of same is returned from the Florida Secretary of State.
