

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FRANKLIN COUNTY COMPREHENSIVE PLAN TO CHANGE THE PERMITTED LAND USE OF A PARCEL OF REAL PROPERTY IN SECTION 23, TOWNSHIP 8 SOUTH, RANGE 6 WEST FROM MIXED-USE RESIDENTIAL TO RURAL RESIDENTIAL.

**ORDINANCE 97-4
FRANKLIN COUNTY, FLORIDA**

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Florida has received a recommendation from the Franklin County Planning and Zoning Commission for changing the land use of certain real property, and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County has conducted a public hearing with due public notice,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE FRANKLIN COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS that the permitted land use of a parcel of real property containing approximately 110 acres in Section 23, Township 8 South, Range 6 West, as shown on the attached map, is changed from Mixed-Use Residential to Rural Residential.

This Ordinance adopted this 18th day of February, 1997, in a regular meeting of the Franklin County Board of County Commissioners after notice was duly given, and pursuant to Chapter 163, Florida Statutes. This Ordinance shall take effect when notice of receipt of a certified copy of same is returned from the Secretary of State.
