

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE TIME FOR SALE OF ALCOHOLIC AND INTOXICATING BEVERAGES.

ORDINANCE NO. 82-2

FRANKLIN COUNTY, FLORIDA

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Florida is charged with the duty of regulating the time for sale of alcoholic and intoxicating beverages, and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Florida, has determined that no alcoholic beverages may be sold, consumed, served, or permitted to be served or consumed in any place holding a license under the Beverage Law of the State of Florida for sale of alcoholic beverages, between the hours of midnight and 7:00 A.M. of the following day, except certain holidays, and weekend days, previously approved for sale by this Board since 1970,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY, FLORIDA, that no alcoholic beverages may be sold, consumed, served, or permitted to be served or consumed in any place holding a license for the sale of alcoholic beverages, between the hours of midnight and 7:00 A.M. of the following day, except that alcoholic beverages may be sold, consumed, served, or permitted to be served or consumed between midnight and 2:00 A.M. of the following day, on the below listed weekends and holidays:

Friday night and Saturday night each weekend;

Christmas Eve and Christmas;

New Year's Eve;

Fourth of July, and Labor Day;

Thanksgiving.

This Ordinance adopted in open session this 2nd day of March, 1982, after such notice of intent to consider such an ordinance has been made and kept in the ordinance book of the Clerk of this Board for at least 15 days exclusive of Sundays and Legal holidays, and the title and substance hereof published according to law in the Apalachicola Times, a newspaper of general

circulation within the County.
