

FRANKLIN COUNTY ORDINANCE 99-10

AN ORDINANCE OF FRANKLIN COUNTY DISSOLVING THE  
FRANKLIN COUNTY INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY  
AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Board of County Commissioners established the Franklin County Industrial Development Authority by Resolution March 5, 1985, and

WHEREAS, all bonds and obligations of the Franklin County Industrial Development Authority are paid, and

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Industrial Development Authority is inactive but subject to reporting requirements and fees, and

WHEREAS, it will be more efficient to dissolve the Franklin County Industrial Development Authority and recreate it if needed,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY:

1. Pursuant to Section 189.4042, Florida Statutes, the Franklin County Industrial Development Authority is dissolved.
2. Assets of the former authority, if any, are the property of Franklin County.
3. This Ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.

The Ordinance is adopted this third day of August, 1999, after notice according to law.
