AN ORDINANCE AMENDING FRANKLIN COUNTY ORDINANCE 95-13.

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Construction Industry Licensing Board has recommended amending Ordinance 95-13 to delete maintenance man as a specialty contractor; to add specialty cleaning contractor as a specialty contractor; and to amend section (12)(2), and

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Board of County Commissioners has held a public hearing to consider these changes,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE FRANKLIN COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS that,

1. Section 13(1)(o) Maintenance Man Contractor is hereby deleted.
2. Section (13)(1) is amended to include the following:

(aa) <u>Specialty Cleaning Contractors</u>	<u>RESIDENTS</u>	<u>NON-RESIDENTS</u>
The annual fees shall be as follows:	\$50.00	\$150.00

3. Section (12)(2) is deleted and the following language is inserted as the new Section (12)(2):

A registration which is inoperative because of failure to timely renew shall be restored on payment of the proper registration fee, if the application for restoration is completed within 90 days after such September 30 and the applicant otherwise complies with the requirements of this Ordinance. If the application for restoration of a registration is not completed within the 90 day period following September 30, then such registration shall become delinquent. A delinquent registration shall not be restored at any future period until such applicant has paid double the registration fee and otherwise complied with the requirements of this Ordinance and, in addition, the Board may require re-examination of the applicant. All delinquent registration shall be restored as provided herein; a new registration shall not, at any time, be issued in the same category in which a registration has become delinquent.

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Board of County Commissioners has held a public hearing to consider these changes,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE FRANKLIN COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS that

1. Section 13(1)(o) Maintenance Man Contractor is hereby deleted.
2. Section 13(1) is amended to include the following:

(aa) Specialty Cleaning Contractors _____ \$25.00

3. Section (12)(2) is deleted and the following language is inserted as the new Section (12)(2):

A registration which is inoperative because of failure to timely renew shall be restored on payment of the proper registration fee, if the application for restoration is completed within 90 days after such September 30 and the applicant otherwise complies with the requirements of this Ordinance. If the application for restoration of a registration is not completed within the 90 day period following September 30, then such registration shall become delinquent. A delinquent registration shall not be restored at any future period until such applicant has paid double the registration fee and otherwise complied with the requirements of this Ordinance and, in addition, the Board may require re-examination of the applicant. All delinquent registrations shall be restored as provided herein; a new registration shall not, at any time, be issued in the same category in which a registration has become delinquent.

This Ordinance shall take effect June 30, 2000.

This ordinance adopted in open regular meeting this 16th day of May, 2000, after notice of intent to consider the same has been made in conformance with Chapter 125.66 (6) Florida Statutes.
