

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FRANKLIN COUNTY COMPREHENSIVE PLAN TO CHANGE THE PERMITTED LAND USE OF A PARCEL OF PRIVATE REAL PROPERTY IN SECTION 23, TOWNSHIP 8 SOUTH, RANGE 6 WEST FROM RURAL RESIDENTIAL TO RESIDENTIAL.

**ORDINANCE 98-2
FRANKLIN COUNTY, FLORIDA**

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Florida has received a recommendation from the Franklin County Planning and Zoning Commission for changing the land use of a certain parcel of private real property, and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County has conducted a public hearing with due public notice,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE FRANKLIN COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS that:

The permitted land use of a parcel of private real property containing 10 acres in Section 23, Township 8 South, Range 6 West, also known as lots 7 and 8 of the unrecorded subdivision of Emerald Point, as shown on the attached map, is changed from Rural Residential to Residential.

This Ordinance adopted this 20th day of JANUARY, 1998, in a regular meeting of the Franklin County Board of County Commissioners after notice was duly given, and pursuant to Chapter 163, Florida Statutes. This Ordinance shall take effect when notice of receipt of a certified copy of same is returned from the Secretary of State.
