

AIRPORT ZONING ORDINANCE FOR FRANKLIN COUNTY, FLORIDA.

ORDINANCE  
FRANKLIN COUNTY

#72 - 4

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS  
OF FRANKLIN COUNTY, FLORIDA:

It is hereby found that a need exists for zoning at the Apalachicola airport, and it is accordingly ordained by the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Florida:

1. All of Sections 3 and 10 in Township 9 South, Range 8 West, 1,000 feet or more South of the runways at the Apalachicola Airport and North of State Road 30, is hereby zoned as residential.

2. No nonconforming use shall be permitted within the described area, except by a nonconforming use permit issued by the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Florida.


3. It shall be a misdemeanor to commit or permit a nonconforming use within the residential area without a nonconforming use permit.


This ordinance shall take effect December 10, 1972, and violation of this ordinance shall be a misdemeanor.

This ordinance adopted in open session this 5th day of December, 1972, after notice of intent to consider such an ordinance has been made and kept in the ordinance book of the clerk of this board for at least 15 days exclusive of Sundays and legal holidays, and the title and substance hereof published according to law in the Apalachicola Times, a newspaper of general circulation within the county.
