

ORDINANCE 2003- 12
FRANKLIN COUNTY, FLORIDA

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING GLASS CONTAINERS
IN OR ON ALL PUBLIC BEACHES, PUBLIC PARKS, OR
PUBLIC RECREATIONAL AREAS IN FRANKLIN COUNTY
FLORIDA; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION;
AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN
COUNTY, FLORIDA.

SECTION 1.

POSSESSION OR USE OF GLASS CONTAINERS: No person shall possess or use
any glass container in or on any public beach, public park, or public recreational area in Franklin
County, Florida.

SECTION 2.

FIRST OFFENSE: \$50.00 fine
SECOND OFFENSE: \$100.00 fine
THIRD OFFENSE: Any persons violating the provision of this ordinance

for the shall be guilty of a misdemeanor of the second degree, punishable as provided in Florida
Statutes.

SECTION 3.



EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall take effect the 18th day of March, 2003,
