

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FRANKLIN COUNTY COMPREHENSIVE PLAN TO CHANGE THE PERMITTED LAND USE OF A PARCEL OF PRIVATE REAL PROPERTY ON THE NEW RIVER FROM AGRICULTURAL TO RESIDENTIAL.

**ORDINANCE 96-12
FRANKLIN COUNTY, FLORIDA**

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Florida has received a recommendation from the Franklin County Planning and Zoning Commission for changing the land use of certain private real property, and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County has conducted a public hearing with due public notice,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE FRANKLIN COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS that:

The permitted land use of a parcel of private real property containing approximately 10 acres located on the New River in Sections 11 and 14, Township 7 South, Range 5 West , as shown on the attached map, is changed from Agricultural to Residential.

This Ordinance adopted this 6th day of August, 1996, in a regular meeting of the Franklin County Board of County Commissioners after notice was duly given, and pursuant to Chapter 163, Florida Statutes. This Ordinance shall take effect when notice of receipt of a certified copy of same is returned from the Secretary of State.
