

ORDINANCE

No. F-72-2

An Ordinance relating to occupational license taxation authorizing Franklin County to levy occupational license taxes; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the County of Franklin, Florida:

Section 1. Franklin County hereby levies an occupational license tax and authorizes the issuance of occupational licenses as authorized by the provisions of Chapter 72-306, General Laws of Florida.

Section 2. The classification for the measurement of the tax and the tax itself shall be the same as was authorized under the provisions of Chapter 205, Florida Statutes, as it existed in law prior to April 24, 1972.

Section 3. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.

Violation of this ordinance shall be a misdemeanor.

This ordinance is adopted in open session this 1st day of June, 1972, and the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Florida hereby declares that an emergency exists as recited herein, and immediate enactment of this ordinance is necessary, all members of the said board being present and, having waived notice, unanimously voted for this ordinance as an emergency ordinance.
