

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING THAT THE COUNTY-OWNED PARKING LOT BETWEEN COMMERCE STREET AND WATER STREET IN BLOCK B1 OF THE CITY OF APALACHICOLA SHALL BE FOR COURTHOUSE EMPLOYEES AND VISITORS ONLY; PROVIDING A PENALTY.

ORDINANCE NO. 83-6

FRANKLIN COUNTY, FLORIDA

WHEREAS, Franklin County, Florida, owns a parking lot behind the Franklin County Courthouse, in Apalachicola, and,

WHEREAS, such lots was constructed for the use of courthouse employees and visitors, and

WHEREAS, excessive use of the said parking lot by vehicles for other private or commercial use has well-nigh preempted much of the parking space in said lot, to the great inconvenience of the courthouse employees and visitors,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY, FLORIDA, in order to promote the health, safety and welfare of the people of Franklin County, Florida:

1. Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 13, 14, 15, and 16, in Block B1 of the City of Apalachicola, Florida, the Franklin County Courthouse Parking Lot, are hereby restricted to employees and visitors at the Franklin County Courthouse for Courthouse business only.

2. All Courthouse Officials and employees shall park their vehicles at the said parking lot only.

3. Parking in said parking lot for other than Courthouse business shall be a misdemeanor.

The Ordinance adopted in open session this 20th day of September, 1983, after such notice of intent to consider such an ordinance has been made and kept in the ordinance book of the Clerk of this Board for at least 15 days exclusive of Sundays and legal holidays and the title and substance hereof published according to law in the Apalachicola Times, a newspaper of general circulation within the County.
