

ORDINANCE 91-6

FRANKLIN COUNTY, FLORIDA

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 78-4 TO PROHIBIT THE OPERATION OF ANY MOTOR VEHICLE ON, IN, OVER, ACROSS OR THROUGH THE BEACHES AND DUNES IN THE ST. THERESA AND YENT BAYOU AREAS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY, FLORIDA.

WHEREAS, Ordinance 78-4 failed to include the St. Theresa and Yent Bayou areas as areas where vehicular traffic is prohibited on, in, over, across, or through the beaches and dunes, and

WHEREAS, vehicular traffic on the beaches and dunes in the St. Theresa and Yent Bayou areas has become a problem, damaging the fragile ecosystem in this area and threatening the safety of persons who may be on the beaches or dunes in these areas.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE FRANKLIN COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

Section 4 of Ordinance 78-4 be amended to include the following areas:

... South of U.S. 98 from SR 65 to Carrabelle Beach at the west line of Section 2, Township 8 South, Range 5 West; the St. Theresa area South of U.S. 98, including Sections 28, 29, 30 and 31, Township 6 South, Range 2 West...

This Ordinance adopted in open regular meeting this 2nd day of July, 1991, after notice of intent to consider same has been made and kept in the Ordinance Book of the Clerk of the Board for at least fifteen (15) days, exclusive of Sundays and legal holidays, and the title and substance hereof published according to law in the Apalachicola Times, a newspaper of general circulation within the County.

This Ordinance shall take effect when notice of a receipt of a certified copy of same is return from the Secretary of State.
