

AN ORDINANCE OF FRANKLIN COUNTY, FLORIDA WAIVING NOTICE; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY PROHIBITING THE DRIVING OF ALL- TERRAIN VEHICLES, GO-CARTS AND MOTORCYCLES IN PARKS, PUBLIC RECREATIONAL AREAS AND CEMETERIES; PROHIBITING THE DRIVING OF ANY VEHICLE IN SUCH AREAS OFF THE DESIGNATED ROADS AND PARKING LOTS OF SUCH AREAS; PROVIDING DEFINITIONS, PENALTIES AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the driving of All-Terrain Vehicles, Go-Carts and Motorcycles in Parks, Recreational Areas and Cemeteries has caused the destruction of roads and surfaces therein, and

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Board of County Commissioners waives notice requirements by a four fifth vote and declares that an emergency exists and the immediate enactment hereof is necessary, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Florida,

1. An All-terrain vehicle is defined as any vehicle defined as an all-terrain vehicle by Section 316.2074 (3), Florida Statutes, as amended.

2. No person shall drive any all-terrain vehicle, Go-Carts or motorcycle in the parks, public recreation areas or cemeteries in Franklin County.

3. No person shall drive any vehicle in the parks, public recreation areas or cemeteries in Franklin County, except on the roads and parking lots therein.

4. This ordinance shall not apply to licensed funeral directors authorized maintenance personnel or to persons attending funeral services.


5. A violation of this ordinance shall be prosecuted as a misdemeanor, punishable by a fine of up to \$500.00 or imprisonment in the county jail up to 60 days or by both such fine and imprisonment.

6. This ordinance shall become effective upon acceptance by the United States Postal Authorities of a certified copy hereof, for special delivery by certified mail to the Department of State.

This ordinance adopted by the Franklin County Board of County Commissioners June, 18, 1996 after notice of intent to consider it has been kept and published according to law.
