

ST. GEORGE ISLAND COUNTY ROAD SPEED LIMITS

ORDINANCE #75-5
FRANKLIN COUNTY
FLORIDA

WHEREAS, St. George Island, in Franklin County, Florida is a popular vacation area, and has many visitors, part-time residents, and full-time residents using the county roads on said island, and

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County Florida deems it necessary, in order to promote the health, safety, morals, welfare, and convenience, of the public in Franklin County, to establish certain speed zones on St. George Island, and

WHEREAS, the sub-divided parts of said island in St. George Island Gulf Beaches Units 1, 2, and 3, are collectively either business or residential districts, and

WHEREAS, the State of Florida Department of Transportation has suggested that a 30 mile per hour speed zone be established on the below described county roads on St. George Island, now, therefore

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY, FLORIDA:

1. All of St. George Island Gulf Beaches Units 1, 2, and 3 are hereby declared to be business or residence districts within the meaning according to Section 317.233, Florida Statutes.

2. The following county roads on St. George Island hereby declared to county speed zones, as to which the maximum lawful speed shall be thirty-five miles per hour in the daytime or nighttime:

- a. All of Gorrie Drive and Private Road;
- b. All of Gulf Beach Drive;
- c. All of Pine Avenue West of Franklin Boulevard; and
- d. All of Bay Shore Drive except that part East of Neate St.

This ordinance adopted in open session this 15th day of
May, 1975, after notice of intent to consider such an ordinance has been
made and kept in the ordinance book of the Clerk of this Board for at least
15 days exclusive of Sundays and legal holidays, and the title and substance
hereof published according to law in the Apalachicola Times, a newspaper
of general circulation within the county.
