

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AMENDING FRANKLIN COUNTY  
ORDINANCE 92-11 WHICH ESTABLISHED A FEE TO BE CHARGED  
APPLICANTS FOR REZONING, LAND USE MAP CHANGES,  
AND DEVELOPMENT OF REGIONAL IMPACT ORDER APPLICATIONS  
AND AMENDMENTS, BY INCREASING THE APPLICATION FEE FOR  
DEVELOPMENT OF REGIONAL IMPACT APPROVALS AND AMENDMENTS

EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

ORDINANCE NO. 96-9

FRANKLIN COUNTY, FLORIDA

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Board of County Commissioner, by a vote of at least 4/5th of the Board, declares that an emergency exists which necessitates the enactment of this Ordinance, and

WHEREAS, the cost to the Franklin County Board of County Commissioners of consideration of applications for Development of Regional Impact Orders and Amendments which have heretofore been brought before the Franklin County Board of County Commissioners has exceeded the fee set for this in Franklin County Ordinance 92-11;

WHEREAS, the costs of considering these matters should be paid for by those applying for them, rather than the taxpayers of Franklin County, and

WHEREAS, experience has shown that the cost to Franklin County exceeds the application fee for DRI Application and DRI Amendment Applications, and

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Board of County Commissioners finds the cost to the County to be at least as follows:

Application for DRI Amendment	\$5,000.00
Application for DRI Approval	\$5,000.00

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY, FLORIDA, that no application for any of the above shall be considered unless the fee hereby imposed is paid.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that the following fees are hereby imposed:

Application for DRI Amendment	\$5,000.00
Application for DRI Approval	\$5,000.00

This Ordinance adopted in special session this 4<sup>TH</sup> day of June, 1996 as an Emergency Ordinance upon a waiver of notice requirements by a 4/5th vote of the membership of the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Florida, said 4/5th majority of said Commission hereby declares that an emergency exists and that the immediate enactment of this Ordinance is necessary.
