

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FRANKLIN COUNTY COMPREHENSIVE PLAN TO CHANGE THE PERMITTED LAND USE OF A PARCEL OF PRIVATE REAL PROPERTY IN SECTIONS 7 AND 18, TOWNSHIP 8 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST FROM RURAL RESIDENTIAL TO RESIDENTIAL ESTATE.

**ORDINANCE 98- 16
FRANKLIN COUNTY, FLORIDA**

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Florida has received a recommendation from the Franklin County Planning and Zoning Commission for changing the land use of a certain parcel of private real property, and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County has conducted a public hearing with due public notice,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE FRANKLIN COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS that:

The permitted land use of a parcel of private real property consisting of 132 acres of land between Eastpoint and Carrabelle in Sections 7 and 18, Township 8 South, Range 5 West, as shown on the attached map, is changed from Rural Residential to Residential Estate.

This Ordinance adopted this 4TH day of AUGUST, 1998, in a regular meeting of the Franklin County Board of County Commissioners after notice was duly given, and pursuant to Chapter 163, Florida Statutes.
