

ORDINANCE NO. 73-5A

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE CONSTRUCTION OF ANY BUILDING OR THE MAKING OF ANY ELECTRIC POWER HOOK-UP IN FRANKLIN COUNTY, FLORIDA, WITHOUT A BUILDING PERMIT.

ORDINANCE
FRANKLIN COUNTY, FLORIDA

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. No person, firm or corporation shall construct or begin construction of any building or residence in Franklin County, Florida, until a Franklin County building permit shall have been obtained.

Section 2. No power company shall make a power hook-up for any new construction until the owner or builder of such building obtains a county building permit, and exhibits same to the power company.

Section 3. A violation of this ordinance shall be a misdemeanor, and shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$200.00 or by imprisonment in the County Jail not to exceed sixty (60) days or by both such fine and imprisonment.

This Ordinance shall take effect when notice of receipt of a certified copy of same shall be obtained from the Secretary of State, but not earlier than July 15, 1973.

This ordinance adopted in open session this 3rd day of July, 1973, after notice of intent to consider such ordinance has been made and kept in the ordinance book of this Board for at least 15 days exclusive of Sundays and legal holidays, and the title and substance hereof published according to law in a newspaper of general circulation within the county.
