

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING DRIVING UPON OR OBSTRUCTING AIRPORT RUNWAYS IN FRANKLIN COUNTY.

ORDINANCE NO. 82-1

FRANKLIN COUNTY, FLORIDA

WHEREAS, Franklin County has a public airport at Apalachicola, and

WHEREAS, the runways at the airport should be reserved for use by aircraft, and vehicles and obstructions of any kind should not be permitted upon said runways,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY, FLORIDA, that in order to promote the health, safety, and welfare of the people of Franklin County, that:

1. No vehicle shall be driven upon or parked upon any of the runways at the Apalachicola Airport. Vehicles shall not be permitted upon paved aircraft ramps at the Apalachicola Airport.
2. It shall be unlawful to obstruct any runway or place any obstruction upon any runway at the Apalachicola Airport.
3. Violation of this ordinance shall be a misdemeanor of the first degree, punishable according to law.

This Ordinance adopted in open session this 19th day of January, 1982, after such notice of intent to consider such an ordinance has been made and kept in the ordinance book of the Clerk of the Board for at least 15 days exclusive of Sundays and legal holidays, and the title and substance hereof published according to law in the Apalachicola Times, a newspaper of general circulation within the County.
