

AN ORDINANCE RESCINDING FRANKLIN COUNTY ORDINANCES 98-14 AND 98-15, WHICH WERE ORDINANCES AMENDING THE FRANKLIN COUNTY COMPREHENSIVE PLAN.

**ORDINANCE 99-21
FRANKLIN COUNTY, FLORIDA**

WHEREAS, on August 4, 1998, the Franklin County Board of County Commissioners adopted Ordinances 98-14 and 98-15 to amend the Franklin County Comprehensive Plan, and

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Community Affairs issued its Statement and Notice of Intent regarding the Amendment on September 17, 1998, contending that the adopted ordinances were inconsistent with the Franklin County Comprehensive Plan, and

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Community Affairs initiated formal administrative proceedings challenging the Amendment, and

WHEREAS, both the Franklin County Board of County Commissioners and the Florida Department of Community Affairs, to avoid the expense, delay, and uncertainty of lengthy litigation, negotiated a Stipulated Settlement Agreement, and

WHEREAS, as part of this Stipulated Settlement Agreement the County Commission agreed to rescind Ordinances 98-14 and 98-15,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE FRANKLIN COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS that Franklin County Ordinances 98-14 and 98-15 are hereby rescinded.

This Ordinance adopted this 7th day of December, 1999, in a regular meeting of the Franklin County Board of County Commissioners after notice was duly given, and pursuant to Chapter 163, Florida Statutes..
