

FRANKLIN COUNTY, FLORIDA

ORDINANCE NO. 92 - 10

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE STANDARD BUILDING CODE, ESTABLISHING MINIMUM WIRING SIZE, PROVIDING FOR WINDOW SILL HEIGHT, AND PROVIDING A PENALTY.

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Board of County Commissioners has adopted the Standard Building Code, and

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Board of County Commissioners has ordained that the minimum electric wire size shall be twelve gauge, and

WHEREAS, windows in elevated structures should not be closer to floor level than eighteen inches, and

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Board of County Commissioners wishes to clarify the fact that violation of the Standard Building Code, as amended, is a misdemeanor, and to provide a penalty,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE FRANKLIN COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

1. The Standard Building Code is adopted and shall be the building code of Franklin County, as amended by the Franklin County Board of County Commissioners;

2. No electric wiring smaller than twelve gauge may be installed;

3. Windows in structures constructed on pilings, and all windows the bottom of which is more than thirty inches above grade shall be at least eighteen inches above finished floor level; Provided, that this paragraph shall not apply if the windows are protected by at least eighteen inches of safety glass, or suitable grid or bar system for the bottom of the window.

4. A violation of the Standard Building Code as amended, shall be a misdemeanor, punishable by a fine not to exceed \$500.00 or confinement in the Franklin County jail not to exceed sixty days.


This Ordinance adopted in open regular meeting this 1st day of December, 1992, after notice of intent to consider same has been made and kept in the Ordinance Book of the Clerk of the Board for at least fifteen (15) days, exclusive of Sundays and legal holidays, and the title and substance hereof published according to law in the Apalachicola Times, a newspaper of general circulation within the county.

This Ordinance shall take effect when notice of a receipt of a certified copy of same is returned from the Secretary of State.
