

AN ORDINANCE IMPOSING A 25 TON LOAD LIMIT ON EXISTING PAVED ROADS ON ST. GEORGE ISLAND AND PROHIBITING TRUCK TRAFFIC ON CERTAIN ROADS ON ST. GEORGE ISLAND.

ORDINANCE NO. 83-3

FRANKLIN COUNTY, FLORIDA

WHEREAS, heavy traffic and especially heavy trucks have caused excessive damage to Franklin County roads on St. George Island, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to protect said road from excessive wear and damage, so that they will remain usable,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY, that:

1. There shall be a 25 ton maximum load limit on all paved county maintained and owned roads on St. George Island and;
2. No truck (except pickup trucks) nor any vehicle larger than a pickup truck shall drive on or traverse the following roads on St. George Island:

Gulf Beach Drive West of Franklin Boulevard; Private Drive; 11th Street East; 12th Street West; and Gorrie Drive.

Provided, however, that trucks may enter said roads for access to any lot, travelling only from the nearest other road to said lot, and returning to the nearest other road. It is intended by this paragraph to allow access to lots, but not to permit through traffic.

This Ordinance adopted in open session this 5th day of July, 1983, after such notice of intent to consider such an ordinance has been made and kept in the ordinance book of the Clerk of this Board for at least 15 days exclusive of Sundays and legal holidays and the title and substance hereof published according to law in the Apalachicola Times, a newspaper of general circulation within the County.
