AN ORDINANCE IMPOSING A 15 MILE
PER HOUR SPEED LIMIT IN LANARK
VILLAGE IN FRANKLIN COUNTY, FLORIDA,

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Board of County Commissioners has determined that the present 35 miles per hour speed limit in Lanark Village should be reduced to 15 miles per hour in order to protect the health, safety and welfare of the people of Franklin County, Florida.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY the Franklin County Board of County commissioners that it shall be unlawful for any vehicle to travel at any speed exceeding fifteen (15) miles per hour in Lanark Village, Franklin County, Florida, upon the following streets:

Club Court, Pine Street, Collins Avenue, Parker Avenue, Hefferman Drive, Caldwell Avenue, Warren Avenue, Holland Avenue, Carlton Avenue, Magnolia Street, according to Franklin county Plat Book 2 at page 14, 14A, 18, & 19.

A violation of the ordinance shall be prosecuted in the same manner as a misdemeanor and shall be punishable by imprisonment in the county jail not exceeding thirty days or a fine not exceeding three hundred dollars or by both such fine and such imprisonment, or as prohibited in Section 316.655, Florida Statutes.

This Ordinance shall take effect upon receipt by the Clerk of this Board of notice of receipt of this ordinance by the Department of State.
